

# Behavior Plan

We have a color changing system in our classroom for behavior and your child will receive a ticket daily to let you know how his/her day was. The ticket colors are as follows:

**Green:** I had a great day or I only received one warning (the blue space on our classroom chart is for 1 warning).

**Yellow:** I had an OK day (I received 2 warnings).

**Red:** I had a bad day (I need to work on my behavior).

Once your child receives 10 green or yellow tickets, they can turn them in for a prize from the treasure box. If your child receives a red ticket, *please sign* the ticket and return it to me ***the next school day*** in their daily folder. If I do not get the ticket back, I will assume you did not see it and your child will start the day on yellow.

Please do not imagine your child has a behavior problem or that I do not like them if they receive a few red tickets. Transitioning into the daily routine of Kindergarten is not an easy thing for a five year old and they may need some time to adjust. Be assured, if your child is truly having a problem, I will contact you to set up a meeting to discuss it.
